# Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Overview

- The CDBG program provides annual grants on a formula basis to entitled states, cities, and counties. Authorized under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, Public Law 93-383, as amended 42 U.S.C. 5301 et seq.
- To develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment, and by expanding economic opportunities, principally for low and moderate income persons.
- Grantees carry out a wide range of community development activities directed toward revitalizing neighborhoods, economic development, and providing improved community facilities and services.

# Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Overview

- The ESG Program provides annual grants on a formula basis to cities, urban counties, territories, and states
- Authorized under The McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, As Amended by S. 896 Homeless Emergency Assistance and Rapid Transition to Housing (HEARTH) Act of 2009
- The ESG Program is aimed at assisting people to quickly regain stability in permanent housing after experiencing a housing crisis and/or homelessness.

### CDBG & ESG Activities

- Activities are carried out directly by Community Development or through the engagement of Subrecipients (often Non-profit Organizations)
  - CDBG Activities cover:
    - Community Facilities
    - Economic Development
    - Public Services & Youth Assistance
  - ESG Activities cover:
    - Street outreach
    - Emergency Shelter
    - Homelessness Prevention
    - Rapid Re-housing Assistance
    - Homeless Management Information System (HMIS)
- All Housing related activities are carried out by LHAND


